

**General Provisions:**

1. **Registration:**

1. Participation in the conference is free of charge.

**Conference Cancellation:**

1. The organizer reserves the right to cancel the conference without providing a reason. In such a case, participants have no right to complain about the cancellation.

**Image Clause:**

In accordance with Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (OJEU L No 119, p. 1), hereinafter referred to as GDPR, we hereby inform you that:

- 1) The administrator of your personal data is the Organizer (hereinafter referred to as the "Administrator"). - 2) The Administrator has appointed a Data Protection Officer. - 3) Participant personal data will be stored for a period of 60 months.
- 4) The Organizer will not transfer participant personal data to a third country or international organization. If such transfer is necessary, data subjects will be informed accordingly.
- 5) Individuals whose data is processed have the right to access their personal data and the right to request rectification, erasure, or restriction of processing of their personal data, the right to data portability, as well as the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection (Warsaw, Stawki 2 Street), if they consider that the processing of their personal data violates the GDPR.
- 6) Individuals have the right to object at any time to the processing of their data to the extent arising from the GDPR. In such a situation, the Administrator will cease processing the data for the above purposes, unless it can demonstrate that there are compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights, and freedoms of the data subject or the data is necessary for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims.
- 7) To the extent that data processing is based on consent, individuals whose data is processed have the right to withdraw their consent to the processing of personal data at any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.
- 8) Providing personal data is voluntary, but failure to provide it may result in the inability to participate in the Conference by the Participant.
- 9) Participant personal data is not subject to automated decision-making.
